1. RULES:

- a. **Participation at the CHAMPIONSHIP gala**, will be dependent on the swimmer being **FULLY registered**.
- b. Please note that the swimmers age is at the first day of the competition.
- c. SSA LEVEL 3 events will be used for CTA L2, L3 & SANJ+ CHAMPIONSHIP and adapted to accommodate the SANJ+ swimmers.
- d. All events will be swum as timed finals.
- e. Gala will take place over 3 days.
- f. **Swimmers may enter the CHAMPIONSHIP if they have participated in 2 CAPE TOWN AQUATICS meets in the 2019/2020 season.**
- g. **SANJ+ swimmers may swim the events they have qualified for and the events with CT3 qualifying times in the **SANJ+ session only**. There are no qualifying times for any of the 50's events (Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke and Butterfly). Swimmers who have qualified in any event may in addition to their 3 unqualified additional events (100m and longer), choose any of the 50's provided they have times on the database for the particular event.**
 - Swimmers 11&u with SANJ Qt's may compete in the Level 3 session. Please note that should swimmer choose to swim down, he/she **MUST** compete **ONLY** in the Level 3 session.
- h. **LEVEL 3 swimmers may swim the events they have qualified for and the events with CT2 qualifying times in the **LEVEL 3 session only**.**



- Swimmers 10&u with Level 3 QT's may compete in the Level 2 session. Please note that should swimmer choose to swim down, he/she **MUST** compete **ONLY** in the Level 2 session.

i. **LEVEL 2** swimmers may swim the events they have qualified for and the events with CT1+ qualifying times in the **LEVEL 2 session only**.

- Swimmers 9&u that has achieved one Level 2 qualifying time may participate at CTA Level 1 CHAMPIONSHIPS as well.

j. NT's **will not** be accepted.

k. Heats will be swum fast to slow.

l. If a swimmer has entered the

- 1500 Free he/she may request splits for the 800 Free and 400 Free
- 800 Free he/she may request splits for the 400 Free

- **Please note that swimmer must still enter for the split events.**

m. **Events for Para swimmers** – Any Para swimmer may compete at CHAMPIONSHIP gala. There are no QT's, but swimmers must have times on the SSA Database. All Para swimmers will compete in the SANJ+ sessions.

n. No relays will be swum.

o. Medals will be presented to the first three swimmers in each age group each event per Level category.

p. **Except for West Coast, no other out of district swimmers** may participate at this championship.

q. There will be **NO** trophies.

2. SCRATCHINGS:

- Swimmers that wish to scratch from events may do so up to 60 min before the start of the relevant session.
- Only team managers allowed to do scratchings.
- Medical certificate or good cause will overrule other scratching rules.
- No show fine of R300 per event** will be charged. Swimmer will only be allowed to participate in his/her remaining events once this fine has been settled at the admin table.

3. AGE GROUPS FOR MEDALS:

- Level 2 : 10&u; 11; 12; 13; 14; 15-16; 17&o
- Level 3 : 11&u; 12; 13; 14; 15-16; 17&o
- SANJ+ : 12&u; 13; 14; 15-16; 17&o
- Disabled : 14&u; 15&o



4. POINTS:

5. MEDALS:

- LEVEL 2 : Medals will be presented to the first 3 swimmers in each event and age group.
- LEVEL 3 : Medals will be presented to the first 3 swimmers in each event and age group.
- SANJ+ : Medals will be presented to the first 3 swimmers in each event and age group.
- Medal winners must be neatly attired in their relevant club uniforms.

6. ENTRIES:

- Entry fee per individual event: R50.00
- Surcharge : R40 (programs & gate entry fees will not be charged at all)
- All entries must be done on TM and forward to, Lucinda Koch – swimboard@ctmaquatics.co.za
- Closing date for entries will be the **4th of February 2020.**

7. OFFICIALS:

- Probation timekeepers will NOT be allowed to officiate at this meet.**
- 1 official for every 3 swimmers entered /session/club.**
- The names of the officials must be submitted on the Technical Officials document completed and sent in together with gala entries on or before the 4th of February 2020.
- Should your club not meet the correct officials' ratio per session per meet, your club will have to buy the services of a correctly accredited official. These services are R250 per official per session per meet.
- All Technical Officials must be correctly attired.
- White shirts and Navy-Blue Trousers or skirts.
- Should an official not be properly attired the club will be fined R100 per official.

8. PROTESTS:

- Protests must be submitted, in writing, by the appointed Team Manager, with a R500 deposit to the meet referee.
- Within 30 minutes of the incident in question.

9. GATE & PROGRAM CHARGES:

- There **will not be gate entry fees or programs for sale.**

- c. Team managers & coaches will receive programs at the Team Managers meeting.
